Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This article has some merits; still it is rather poor written. Therefore, I used track changes option and I made several changes. The authors should take them into consideration and if agree they can accept them. However, there are many others that should be made. First of all, English seems to be not very good.</p> <p>Other observations: The title seems to be rather too long. I suggest to be simplified. There are too long phrases in the "Introduction", which hardly can be followed. This part could be eliminated, because seems to be propaganda: The economy of Port Harcourt is vibrant and offers myriad opportunities for business, investment, and tourism. There is also significant horticultural activity within the metropolitan area. This has earned Port Harcourt the appellation, "The Garden City". Similar: Port Harcourt is well endowed with all the infrastructure of a modern city international and domestic airports, seaports, hotels, and conference facilities. The Port Harcourt International Airport is located in Omagwa, about 30 minutes' drive from the city centre. Port Harcourt is connected to the world and the rest of Nigeria with a vast array of airlines that fly to Paris, Frankfurt, Lagos, and Abuja. These two phrases could be eliminated, but the authors can add references for everybody to find them elsewhere. In the Discussion part: Too long phrases; should be divided: In their study, they found that variables which had significant influence on the occupational health problems were knowledge on occupational health hazard (p=0.016), work experience (p=0.021), health check-up (p=0.042) and for the occupational health injuries were monthly income (p=0.036), knowledge to prevent from health risk (p=0.001), gender (p=0.02), and knowledge of occupational health hazard (p=0.011), work experience (p= 0.025), work type (p=0.001), knowledge on PPEs (p=0.034) and knowledge on work-related health risks(p= 0.027).</p>
