Compulsory REVISION comments	The introduction lacks the information on the socioeconomic aspects of the inhabitants of the region. The political aspect which influences the poverty of the population in general, was not treated. Specify whether the geographical position and political influences on the economy or not. Most definitions reported in "Concept of NTFPs" are repeated phrases from the introduction. From my point of view, there is no need to present this section as specified in the introduction (the concepts of NTFPs). The study area lacks the information on the population density for each sampled subarea. Figure 1 corresponding to information about the limitations of "Edo and Delta states bound Ondo (East), on the Ogun and Osun states (West), Ekiti and Kogi states (North) and the Bight of Benin and the Atlantic Ocean (South) " it was not presented in the text. Line 130: Under the concept of vegetation, the manuscript provides a list of species based on the book of Keay (1959), on the classification of Nigerian vegetation, where they present the dominant species of different areas: a) the magoroves; b) rain forest; c) the avanna. However, the paper does not present the list of species of timber forest most important from the point of view of the economic (bioenergy, medicinal plants, handicrafts, fiber production, food and construction). Method of Data Analysis which aims to apply the descriptive statistics, this confusing. The methodology does not specify the registered variables (qualitative and quantitative variables). A descriptive analysis of information is not just a simple calculating of percentage values; it is important to use the non - parametric statistics as evidence of goodness of fit chi-square contingency tables and nonparametric ANOVA (Friedman test and Cochran for example). Therefore, this manuscript only limit calculates the percentage values. Hypotheses Tested. The hypotheses are not consistent with the methodology.
