So, kindly revise these parts of Results where reference numbers have been specified.</li> <li>In addition, in certain parts of the section as 3.2 heading for instance, you use the pronoun “I” instead of “We”. It is more suitable to use impersonal form for scientific writing. Please go through all the manuscript and changed.</li> </ul> <p><b>Discussion</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Although we have demonstrated an increase in ILC populations upon administration of Co-Q10 and that these cells in protective immunity, you had to measured parasitemia and compared it between the three experimental groups.</li> <li>So, specify limitations of the study</li> </ul> <p><b>Conclusion</b> Add a conclusion within this manuscript</p> <p><b>Others</b> Sections such as “Acknowledgment”, “Conflict of interest” and “Abbreviations” are missing. Please add them within this manuscript</p>
