Figure 1 is missing titles on both the Y and X-axis.</p> <p>References David et al., (2010)¹⁴ was cited in the study design (Inoculation with <i>Plasmodium berghei</i>) In the list of references, the article was shown to be published in 2004. Similarly, Sowunmi et al., (2010)²⁰ in the discussion was shown to be published in 2009 in the list of references. These have to be verified and rectified.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>Introduction Plasmodium should be in italics. This needs to be fixed in the entire article. With Dex known act chiefly on certain.... Statement is not clear</p> <p>Scope of the study "Study was designed to be ex-vivo, adopting albino mice (Swiss strain) as experimental mode." Did the authors mean "model" Study was conducted with at the animal house.....Statement is not clear</p> <p>Study design "ad libitum" should be italicized.</p> <p>Inoculation with <i>Plasmodium Berghei</i> "Malaria parasites, <i>plasmodium berghei</i> were obtained...." Generic name should be in capital letter (<i>Plasmodium berghei</i>)</p> <p>Nigerian Institute of Medical Research is NIMR not NMR.</p> <p>"Determination was then done by counting at least,...." Could the authors be more specific by saying "Parasitaemia was determined by counting....."</p> <p>Results Figure 1: "Showing Changes in Haematological variables....." Consider removing "showing"</p> <p>X-axis title for figure 1-7 "Hematological parameters"; as well as Figure 5 and 6 legend. Typos "Hematological". Consider using British spelling to stay consistent with the way it was previously written "haematological".</p> <p>Discussion Typos "resistance to diseases like malari¹⁶" Overtime, Malaria... consider using lower case for malaria.</p>
