samples to minimum of 50, no percentages could be calculated. Considering the fact that I have spent over 7 years in	
Nigeria, I'm fully aware of the hygienic conditions of the barber "chops".	
The editor can decide if they want to publish it or not.	
I still maintain that collecting 1-1 sample for cultivation from 10 different barber saloons (with 2 o) from Benin city	
is far not enough to conclude anything and percentage cannot be calculated. I rather think that the barber shops	
in question are not "barber chops"! It is still not clear that "ensured to disinfect the perimeter inside the barber's	
chop in order to prevent contamination" how was performed (disinfecting the floor before the hair was dropped?). As far	
as I have spent several years working in Africa, I'm fully aware of the problems of such sampling and the hygienic	
conditions in a barber "chop".
