

### **Editor's Comment:**

I have gone through all the stages for evaluating the manuscript under review and my comments are as follows:

1. Both reviewers have made scientifically sound comments on the manuscript and I do agree with their comments.

None of the reviewers rejected the manuscript. However, as per my view, the authors have tried but not fully complied with the instructions of the reviewers,

I hereby recommend that the **manuscript “Physico-chemical characterization of palm kernel oil extracted from the seeds of two varieties of oil palm (*Elaeisguineensis*Jacq.) for a possible use in feed or food”** be accepted for publication in our Journal after below mentioned corrections.

1. The whole manuscript is poorly written in terms of grammar. The author needs to remove these grammatical errors present throughout the manuscript. It would be better to take help of some English Language grammar expert.

2. The Introduction part is still lacking the flow and some information provided is not as per the findings of the manuscript. The main focus of Introduction part is on citing literature about effects of feeding palm oil as animal feeds. Similarly, as mentioned by one of the reviewers also, in Result discussion part, there is discussion about the antimicrobial, anti-viral and plaque removal properties of fatty acids. However, the authors have just confirmed the types of fatty acids present in the two varieties of oils. Therefore, the discussion part should include only the discussion relevant to their findings
