

Editor's Comment:

The manuscript has been improved after reviewing, but is still subject to several corrections before being published.

- Text

Several corrections have been directly written (highlighted in yellow) on the text given in attached file.

Page 14., Discussion. The sentence "Also because its spores are common component of aerosols and they drift on air current dispersing themselves both short and long distances and when in contact with solid feeds or liquid surfaces they tend to germinate if the condition of the moisture is right and this view is consistent with the findings of Gioconda and Richard,..." is long and hard to be understood. It needs to be re-written, perhaps divided into two sentences.

Check the names of mycotoxicogenic organism: for genus: capital letter and italics.

- References.

One of reviewers requested to present the references according to the instructions to the authors, and give them in the list according to their position in the text. Only a part of work has been done: the name of authors and year of publication must be deleted from the text (excepted if the structure of the sentence needs the names). I do it for the third references.

In the list of references, the references must be written according to the instruction to the authors. I also corrected the first three references directly on the text.

The authors considered the note of instructions (Note: Authors are also encouraged to add other database's unique identifier (like PUBMED ID). So, they indicated "PUBMED", or "view at Google scholar" but without giving the ID. Add it (or delete "PUBMED", "view at google scholar"...)

- Plates and figures

"Plate and Figure" must be written in full in the text and in the legend.

Separate Plate 1 from plate 2, etc.
