Sildenafil also is able to reduce pulmonary hypertension (PH) which is an important predictor of mortality in chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)</li> <li>4- The long-term safety of sildenafil is not established, and concerns about side effect are being raised. These side effects could be minimized in a designer drug by combining the principle of selective PDE inhibition with target organ-restricted drug delivery, minimizing systemic actions perhaps by rapid drug metabolism.
