It would be better if the author stated the research questions at the conclusion of the literature review and then posed these in the form of hypotheses which could then be tested in the findings section. The contribution to knowledge provided by the hypothesis testing could then be addressed in the discussion section, which needs to be added. The conclusion should include the research limitations and the suggestions for future research.
