Thus this paper can be resubmitted after complete revision.</b></p> <p>Throughout the paper, spacing should be revised, such as line 26 and 27. Also grammar should be improved, for example, line 27, "case" should be "a case", line 30. "65 years old female" → "A 65 year old female" Line 30-32, this sentence should be split in 2 sentences.</p> <p>Abstract Complication should be plural. Introduction The reference 1 could not be located. Please make sure that the citation is correct. Line 30 AHA should be spelled out Line 32, CKD should be spelled out Line 32 and 33, This sentence should be split in 2 sentences.</p> <p><b>Those mentioned above and other numerous grammatical errors distracted from reviewing the content. All these errors are to be corrected, and the paper is to be resubmitted. Authors are strongly encouraged to have an English speaking medical person to proof read the manuscript before resubmitting it.</b></p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments		
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>There are numerous grammatical problems. The manuscript should have been screened for the basic problems like these before it is sent to a reviewer. I am not inclined to re-review this paper unless these problems are cleared up.</p>
