(ii) The abstract should include some of the recommendations given that it summarizes the content of the manuscript. (iii) The author should write the term "Generation" in full and not "Gen" (iv) Section 3. Methodology should include 3.1 Research Design, 3.2 Population and Sampling procedures under which the issue of sample can be found. Meanwhile, the author should clearly indicate the population and the sample both in numbers. Apparently under 3.1 no sample size was indicated. (v) The author should consider the following numbering of section: 4. Results, 5. Discussions, 6. Conclusion. In addition to these, the manuscript should have a "Recommendations" section which should be numbered 7. (vi) The author should avoid writing fig but he should write figure instead. (vii)References should be revisited thoroughly such that all the first letters of words contained in the titles of books should be in capital letters. The author should follow the example of the number 1 on the list of references (highlighted in red)
