Compulsory REVISION comments	In a prospective study, the authors reported the clinical profile of patients who underwent subtotal thyroidectomy due to the presence of goiter. Approximately 20% of subjects exhibited a giant goiter. Overall, the manuscript is fairly well written, however I recommend a moderate English revision of the text. I suggest the authors to include data on pre- and post-operative complication within a table (how many patients have respiratory problems, tracheomalacia, etc.). In addition, discussion should be more accurate, with references about prevalence of goiter worldwide and its main risk factors.
