Accordingly, test-retest reliability was used which is the most commonly used for reliability test in survey study. It was employed by having the same respondents to complete the survey at two different times. Then, it was quantified by using correlation coefficient and the r-value is 0.77 which indicates that the responses of the respondents were stable
