This is necessary so another research could apply same equations and obtain similar results thus validating these values.</p> <p>For the Methods, although it was stated, a sequential workflow diagram is necessary. This should be included in the paper. This is such that another researcher could follow this method/process sequentially and obtain same results.</p>	<p>we took into account your remarks thanks for the relevance</p>
