This revised paper need to rewrite it, for example : authors need to correct these sentences (i) E_i is the expected number of cases in each category; (ii) The hypothesis about the distribution is rejected at the chosen significance level (α) if the critical value is less than the test statistic defined as $\chi^2_{\alpha, k-p-1}$; (iii) H_0 : Time taken is independent of Number of processes ; (iv) The p-value is .000878. (please explain the formula of p-value clearly); (v) we fail to accept (reject) the null hypothesis meaning the result is significant. This implies that number of processes is dependent on the time taken to obtain a solution, etc..	The sentences have been revised appropriately
