Although the illuminant C glasses were not available, measures were put in to place to ensure adequate daylight illumination also recommended by the test manufacturers. This included performing the color tests outside and with sufficient day light illumination between 9am and 2pm.</p> <p>2. Memorizing of the test plate sequence by the students after being informed by their peers. Efforts were also made to reduce this trend and ensure accuracy by frequently changing the sequence of the plates shown to the students.</p>
