You should unify the style of references (reference on line 243 is unacceptable, etc). 2) Authors should not write details of the 'Materials and Method' section in the Abstract such as 'body weight' and etc. 3) I would recommend to unify the style of charts and figures. The text for some figures is bold and some is not.
