The edmanuscript should be re-structured and some paragraphs re-written.</p> <p><b>Formal English writing should be used in the article...for example....contractions like doesn't, won't,etc must be avoided</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• While targeting cancer stem cells....<b>please clarify this sentence in line 74</b></li> <li>• Association with cancer diagnosis makes it difficult to treat. <b>please clarify this sentence in line 80</b></li> </ul> <p>The greatest armory of these models is just not only to aid us to handle the metabolic changes [2], but also to help us to express the genes. As a consequence, Normal progenitor cells leading to repair and regeneration after the possible occurrence of damages. <b>These paragraph should be re-written....its meaning it is not clear</b></p> <p><b>Table 01 should be organized under a different format....it is not clear what is showing. A title for the table should also be provided.</b></p> <p><b>Figures and diagrams should be better organized since they are difficult to follow</b></p>
