Is the size a factor?</p> <p>2. The conclusion is also too brief.</p> <p>3. I suggest the authors should include a table, comparing the effects of the different types of synthesized AgNPs. Table 3 is not clear. It only indicates the concentration of AgNPs solution but does not specify which type of AgNPs is in the concentration.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	The same referencing style should be used.	
Optional/General comments	It is a good research. However, I suggest that the authors address the issues that I have raised, thoroughly.
