The sample appears to be convenient-this should be stated and its inherent bias. Elaborate that the type of patient presenting (see comments) – for subfertility, menstrual irregularity, etc , that those fulfilling the criteria ..were recruited (for PCOS). These subjects were then evaluated for the variables ?demography and signs and symptoms (kindly see comments in text).</p> <p>Results. Presented satisfactorily . Comments related to the figures should be stated in narrative. Some of this appears under Discussion.</p> <p>Discussion: This section is well presented.</p> <p>Conclusions are acceptable.</p> <p>References. This requires much attention – the format needs to adhere to that of the Journal (Vancouver style).</p> <p>Limitations of the study and how sample size need to be stated.</p>
