I find some grammatical errors; for example, (a) in title of the work, first letters of some words are in capitalized, and others are not; (b) refer to line 492 in page 13: after the word However, the word should be written as in and NOT In. The author should ensure that the paper is error free. 2. Methodology is not written. 3. Objectives written under Abstract are too long; it should be short and as precise as possible. Even some sentences are too long, without much meaning. 4. Under Discussion (page 3), presenting the information under First Topic, Second Topic..... does not make much sense. 5. Refer to line 102 (page 3): Information presented under First Topic is too lengthy. Author should write about the History of the International Court of Justice in not more than 8-10 sentences, as this is not the focal point of study. 6. Conclusion is also too long. It should contain only few catchy points, in line with objectives.
