In table 1, the result of the ADF statistic result provided an evidence of mixed stationarity level where INVT INF MPR MS and EXR were stationary in the order of <math>i(1)</math> while GDP is stationary at <math>i(0)</math> as such, the best estimation tools that should be used is ARDL and not johansen co-integration test due to the mixed stationarity level. If johansen co-integration test will remain, then GDP should be stationary at order <math>1(1)</math> to ensure uniformity with other variable.</p> <p>2. From table 2, result shows the presence of two co-integrating equation as such, the best estimation tools to be use is VECM and not parsimonious ECM as presented in table 3.</p>
