Response rate of 38% is low. However, similar to most of this kind of study 3. Table 1 needs a title 4. Statistical significance vs clinical significance might be totally different thing. For example, in Table 3, Personal Accomplishments, statistically $P < 0.0117$, orthopaedic has a mean of 40.08, anesthesiology, 38.08. The real difference is very small 5.
