Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This is an interesting paper on an important subject which deserves greater consideration. However, there are some problems with the paper.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The first is that the paper is written in a non-academic manner: that is, the literature review should be used to identify gaps in academic knowledge which might be addressed by the research. 2. There should be more details in the methodology section as to how the questionnaire was developed. The sample size should be explained (i.e. why were only 200 questionnaires distributed?). The sample achieved should be compared with the population. Methodology section has to be more detail. Research design, population and sample, data collection method and data analysis method. 3. Abstract: First two sentences describe the same. Describe the problem statement. 4. Population and sample is not clear. Who are the population and respondent???? 5. "they have been analyzed with Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS) 16.0 and the SmartPLS (Partial Least Square) 3.0." These are analytical tool. What are the analytical techniques used for the study. It is not clear. 6. In text citation. Revise in text citations. Example: <i>[17] studied four nature related tourists activities as fishing</i>, This sentence is meaningless. You can write " One of the studies [17] discover four nature related..... etc. 7. Better not to write one sentence paragraphs. 8. End of the problem statement describe the objectives of the study, not in the methodology section. 9. Add a discussion part and describe how results of the study match with the previous findings. 10. Hypothesis: "impact between" is meaningless. Correct the hypothesis.
