Inferring viral quasispecies from 454 pyrosequencing reads. <i>BMC Bioinformatics</i>. 2011;12:S1 Table 3 refereed in the text after the table appears in the manuscript In conclusion, it stated that 'the study found a wide genetic variation in P1, P3, 6K2, Nia-vpg, Nia-pro and Nib gene segments in CBSV whereas, in UCBSV 6K1 and 6K2 gene segments had the highest level of variability', but in abstract it stated that 'The coat protein of the CBSV sequences had nucleotide sequence similarity of 92-100% while P1 and P3 gene had 75-100% and 76-100%, respectively. There is confusion.
