Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>Prevalence of Hp in pts with dyspeptic symptoms in Damaturu.</p> <p>Comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The number of cases is too small to be appropriate for a correct epidemiological assessment. 2) The general concepts derived from the study have been described at least 2 decades ago in the international literature. 3) English language needs gross corrections and many terms are inappropriate from a scientific point of view (e.g.: <i>pervasiveness</i> instead of prevalence; <i>side effects</i> instead of symptoms; <i>the general commonness of Hp disease</i> instead of the overall prevalence of Hp infection, etc..) 4) I would suggest to re-present the data in a short form, as a letter to the Editor.
